Application Materials

The following items must be submitted online via the SLATE application portal ACPE DocuSign link:

- □ Complete ACPE face sheets/both sheets must be signed and dated.
- □ Complete & submit/A reasonably full account of your life.
- □ Complete & submit/A description of your spiritual growth and development.
- Update and submit/A description of your work (vocational history) *and* a resume.
- □ Complete and submit/An account of a "helping incident" (Certificate students).
- □ Complete and submit /Your impressions of CPE (Clinical Pastoral Education).
- Complete and submit Personal & Professional Goals for Clinical Pastoral Education
- □ List three references on the ACPE application in the **Academic Reference** section (1 academic/professional, 1 denominational, and 1 personal). This is a department requirement separate from 3 academic/professional reference letters required by the Graduate School.
- □ Solicit three academic/professional references using the VCU Graduate School reference online prompt. References will be solicited electronically using the email addresses you provide via SLATE.
- □ Submit a helping incident (Certificate applicants).
- □ Submit two verbatims (MS degree/residency applicants).
- □ Submit one self-evaluation and one supervisor's evaluation (MS degree/residency applicants).

Graduate Admissions Requirements

□ Submit GRE score or proof of at least one year of graduate education with a B or better grade-point average.

International Applicants
